

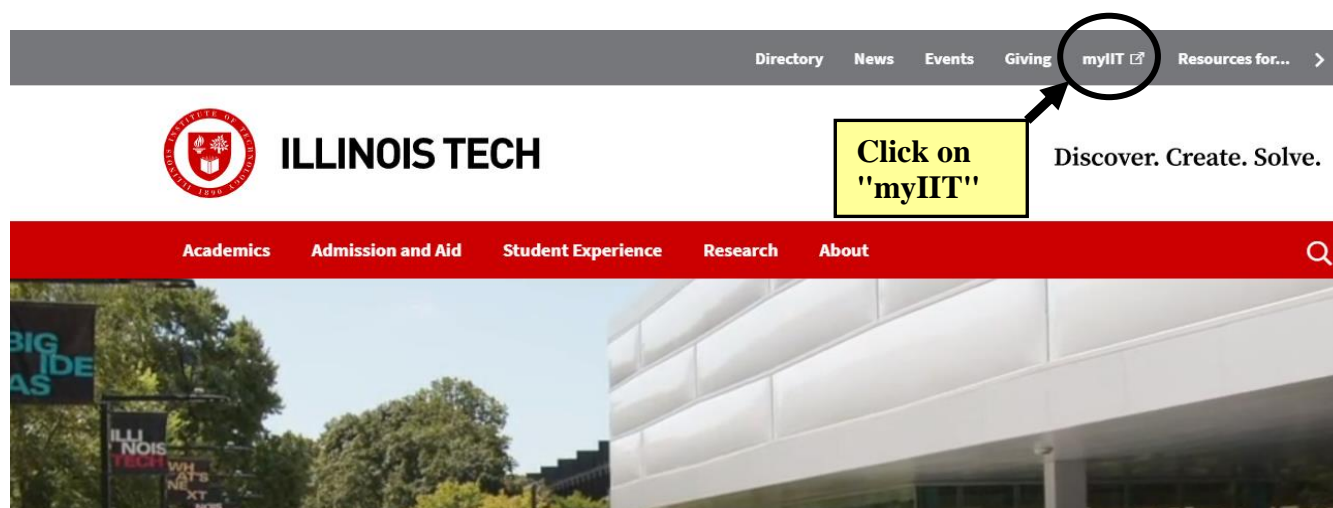
Accessing IIT's Electronic Food Science Resources From Home

Database Authentication

When you are at an IIT Workstation, or using the IIT Wireless Network at either Main Campus, or Moffett Campus (IFSH), you do not need to type in a user name or password to access IIT electronic resources. However, when you are off campus, you must first log into your MyIIT Account before you can access IIT's electronic resources.

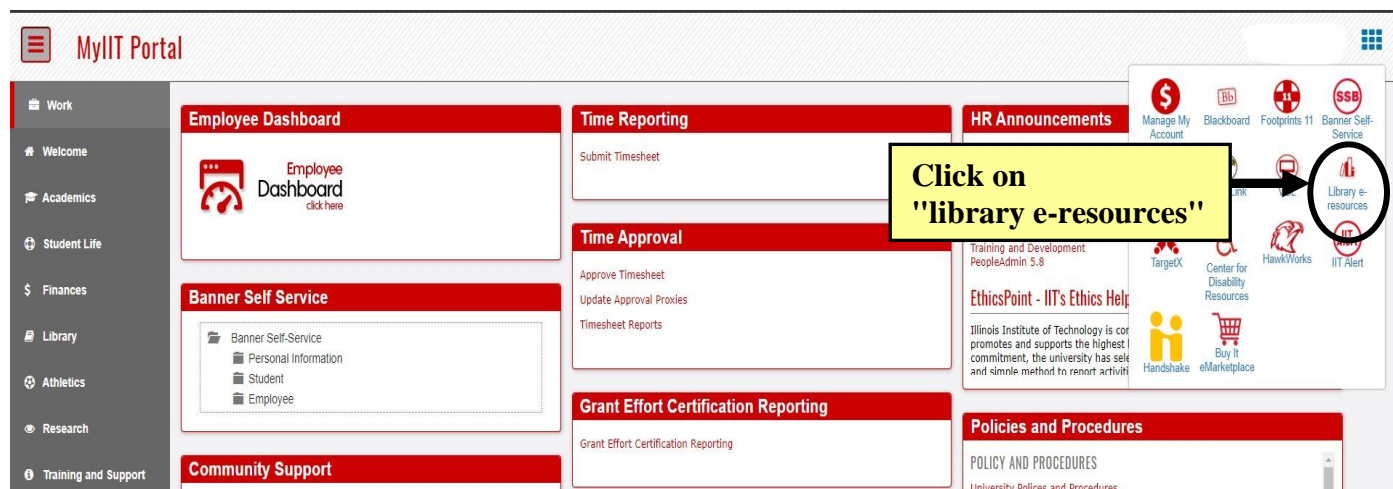
1. Log Into Your My IIT Account

Go to IIT's Homepage at "web.iit.edu" and then click on "myIIT" at the top of the screen.



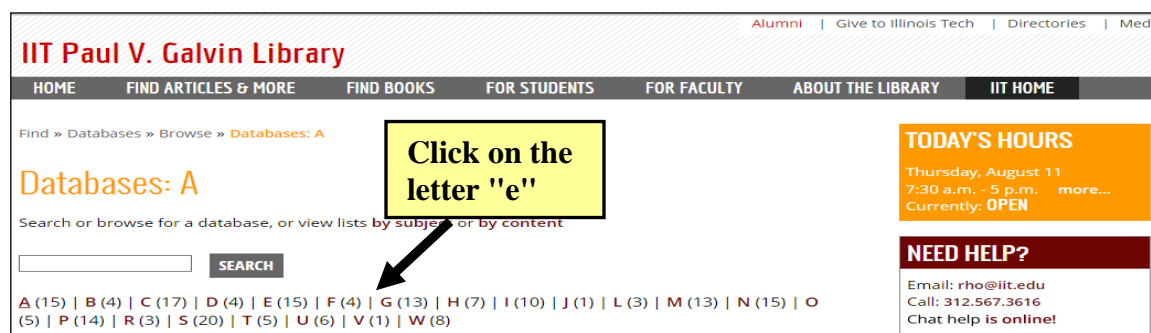
2. Select "library e-resources"

Once you log into your My IIT Account, 'click' at the top right corner of the screen and on the drop down menu, you will find "Library e-resources".



3. Select A Database By Title

Click on the letter that corresponds to the title of the database that you want to access. For example, if you wanted to access the "eBook Collection (EBSCOhost)" you would select the letter "E."



4. Select The Database That You Want To Access

Select "eBook Collection (EBSCOhost)" to access that database. Since you have accessed the database from your MyIIT Account, you will not have to enter a user name or password to access the database.

Primary Food Science Research Databases

The databases below have been arranged from top to bottom based on the number of food science articles contained in each database. Therefore, to be efficient, search the databases from top to bottom in the order that they appear. For graduate research, it is usually best to start off with 2-3 search terms in the databases "Title Field."

- Proquest SciTech Collection
- Web of Science
- Medline
- PubMed

Covers biomedical and life sciences journal literature.
